WORSHIP/SPIRITUAL LIFE

CHILDREN AND THE EUCHARIST The purpose of this ministry is to delight the Heart of Jesus by gently drawing children to encounter him in the Eucharist. We do this in three ways:

Children's Adoration: Saturdays at 3:00 p.m. children ages 4 – 14 gather to adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for one hour of directed prayer, song and reflection. This worldwide movement, founded by Fr. Antoine, fj, was blessed by Pope John Paul II. We can also assist the school and PSR in leading adoration to the religion classes.

Fat Tuesdays: During the summer months, gather children to weekday Mass once a week followed by donuts, goodies, and play time with friends at the playground.
